

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Liquor Service Licence

Customer/Member Service

(e) Hotel – No Dining Room

Licensees are responsible to comply with all general liquor service terms and conditions; terms and conditions specific to the type of licence held; and any terms and conditions specific to the premises

8.0 Customer/Member Service - General

8.1

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the premises are open.

8.2

The licensee may provide food prepared outside the licensed premises or offer prepackaged food acceptable to the LGCA.

9.0 (e) Hotel - No Dining Room

9.1

The licensee is authorized to sell liquor to registered guests for consumption in areas of the

hotel designated under the licence for the times specified in the licence, and from self-serve units installed in guest rooms in the hotel.

9.2

Liquor must not be sold or served in the licensed premises from:

- a) 2:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.; and
- b) 2:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Remembrance Day.

9.3

The licensee may allow a minor to be present in the licensed premises but the minor must not possess or consume liquor.
