

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Liquor Service Licence

# Customer/Member Service

## (b) Personal Services Provider

Licensees are responsible to comply with all general liquor service terms and conditions; terms and conditions specific to the type of licence held; and any terms and conditions specific to the premises.

### 8.0 Customer/Member Service – General

#### 8.1

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the premises are open.

#### 8.2

The licensee may provide food prepared outside the licensed premises or offer prepackaged food acceptable to the LGCA.

### 9.0 (b) Personal Services Provider

#### Definitions

**"personal services provider"** means a business that offers hairstyling or nail or skin care services provided by a person who is authorized to provide those services under *The Apprenticeship and Certification Act*, regardless of whether other services are also provided by that business.

#### 9.1

The licensee is authorized to sell liquor to patrons of the personal services provider for consumption in the licensed premises.

#### 9.2

The licensee may sell liquor for consumption in the licensed premises while services are being provided to a patron and for one hour before and after the provision of services to that patron only within the hours stated in 9.3.

#### 9.3

Liquor must not be sold or served in the licensed premises from:

- a) 2:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.; and
- b) 2:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Remembrance Day.

#### 9.4

The licensee may allow a minor to be present in the licensed premises but the minor must not possess or consume liquor.
