

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Liquor Service Licence

Customer/Member Service

(f) Private Club or Veterans Organization

Licensees are responsible to comply with all general liquor service terms and conditions; terms and conditions specific to the type of licence held; and any terms and conditions specific to the premises.

8.0 Customer/Member Service - General

8.1

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the premises are open.

8.2

The licensee may provide food prepared outside the licensed premises or offer prepackaged food acceptable to the LGCA.

9.0 (f) Private Club or Veterans Organization

Definitions

"**veterans organization**" means an organization whose members are:

- a) current or former members of the Canadian Forces or an allied military force; or
- b) persons who are associated with a person described in clause (a) and who are permitted under the by-laws of the organization to be members of the organization.

9.1

The licensee is authorized to sell liquor for consumption in the licensed premises by members and their guests of:

- a) a private incorporated club without share capital with at least 50 local adult members that is not operated for profit,
- b) a private incorporated club with at least 50 local adult members that operates a golf course, curling club or other athletic facility,
- c) a veterans organization with at least 20 local members.

9.2

Unless otherwise authorized by the LGCA, the licensee may allow guests of members of the private club, to consume liquor in the licensed premises provided that the number of guests in the

licensed premises, excluding spouses or common-law partners of members, does not exceed:

- a) 50% of the local membership of the veterans organization or military unit; or
- b) 10% of the local membership of any other private club.

9.3

Upon authorization of the LGCA the licensee may sell liquor to persons who are not guests or members or other authorized users of the facility who are attending an event at the facility specified in the authorization.

9.4

The licensee must ensure that a person who is not a member, guest or employee of the club does not enter the licensed premises at any time when liquor is served in the licensed premises.

9.5

The licensee must charge a membership fee.

9.6

The licensee must not sell memberships at the door of the licensed premises but may accept applications for membership for consideration at a future meeting of the board of directors of the club.

9.7

Liquor must not be sold or served in the licensed premises from:

- a) 2:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.; and
- b) on Remembrance Day,
 - (i) from 2:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon, if the licensee is a veterans organization, and
 - (ii) from 2:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. for all other licensees.



9.8

The licensee may allow a minor to be present in the licensed premises but the minor must not possess or consume liquor unless:

- a) the liquor is purchased or provided by their adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian; and
- b) the liquor is consumed with a meal in the presence of the minor's adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian.
