Liquor Service Licence

Customer/Member Service

(c) Facility/Residence for Elderly or those requiring Health Care/Support

Licensees are responsible to comply with all general liquor service terms and conditions; terms and conditions specific to the type of licence held; and any terms and conditions specific to the premises.

8.0 Customer/Member Service – General

8.1

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the premises are open.

8.2

The licensee may provide food prepared outside the licensed premises or offer prepackaged food acceptable to the LGCA.

9.0 (c) Facility/Residence for Elderly or those requiring Health Care / Support

9.1

The licensee is authorized to sell or serve liquor to residents or users of the facility or residence and their guests for consumption in the licensed premises.

9.2

Liquor must not be sold or served in the licensed premises from:

- a) 2:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.; and
- b) 2:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Remembrance Day.

9.3

The licensee may allow a minor to be present in the licensed premises but the minor must not possess or consume liquor unless:

- a) the liquor is purchased or provided by his or her adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or quardian; and
- b) the liquor is consumed with a meal in the presence of the minor's adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian.
