

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Liquor Service Licence

Customer/Member Service

(d) Hunting/Fishing Lodges

Licensees are responsible to comply with all general liquor service terms and conditions; terms and conditions specific to the type of licence held; and any terms and conditions specific to the premises.

8.0 Customer/Member Service - General

8.1

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the premises are open.

8.2

The licensee may provide food prepared outside the licensed premises or offer prepackaged food acceptable to the LGCA.

9.0 (d) Hunting/Fishing Lodges

9.1

The licensee is authorized to sell liquor for consumption in the licensed premises to members, guests and other authorized users of the facility during the times when the activities for which the facility is designed are to be conducted. The licensee must operate under the authority of *The Resource Tourism Operators Act*.

9.2

Upon authorization by the LGCA the licensee may sell liquor to persons who are not guests or

members or other authorized users of the facility who are attending an event at the facility specified in the authorization.

9.3

The licensee is also authorized to sell liquor to guests of the lodge for consumption in the guest rooms or cabins.

9.4

Liquor must not be sold or served in the licensed premises from:

- a) 2:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.; and
- b) 2:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Remembrance Day.

9.5

The licensee may allow a minor to be present in the licensed premises but the minor must not possess or consume liquor unless:

- a) the liquor is purchased or provided by his or her adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian; and
- b) the liquor is consumed with a meal in the presence of the minor's adult parent, spouse, common-law partner or guardian.
