TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Liquor Service Licence

Unique Hospitality Venue

Tasting Room

Licensees are responsible to comply with all manufacturing term and conditions, general liquor service terms and conditions, and any terms and conditions specific to the premises.

8.0 Tasting Room Specific

8.1

Liquor must not be sold or served in the tasting room:

- a) from 11:00 p.m. to 11:00 a.m. daily; and
- b) prior to 1:00 p.m. on Remembrance Day.

8.2

The licensee must ensure all patrons vacate the tasting room by 12 midnight.

8.3

A minor may be present in a tasting room if accompanied by their adult parent, spouse, common-law-spouse or guardian but the minor must not possess or consume liquor.

8.4

Only liquor produced at the manufacturing premises may be sold in the tasting room.

8.5

Maximum capacity of the tasting room is 100 persons unless authorized by the LGCA.

8.6

The licensee must ensure that there is a variety of food items available to patrons in the licensed premises at all times that the tasting room is open.

8.7

Games must not be installed in the tasting room unless authorized by the LGCA.
