TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Horse Racing Participant Licence

Owner

Licensees must comply with all general racing participant licence terms and conditions, and terms and conditions specific to the type of racing participant licence held.

3.0 Owner

3.1

A licence ceases to be valid if the licensee no longer owns a race horse.

3.2

The licensee must not appoint an authorized agent to act on their behalf unless the licensee provides written notice to the LGCA.

3.3

The licensee must provide written notice to the LGCA and their trainer of any change or revocation of their authorized agent.

3.4

The licensee must ensure that their authorized agent only performs racing-related acts as described in the rules of racing.

3.5

The licensee must ensure that all horses the licensee owns are registered with the race secretary of each race track operator, and the name, colour, sex, age, breeding and owner(s) of each horse are stated in the registration.

3.6

The licensee must:

- a) provide the LGCA with a list of all horses the licensee owns and the trainer for each horse registered with the race secretary; and
- b) notify the LGCA of any changes to the list of horses the licensee owns.

3.7

The licensee must register any corporations, partnerships, stable names and racing colours with the LGCA.

3.8

The licensee must not be employed or licensed for a race track operator as a race official, officer, managing employee, or track maintenance supervisor.

3.9

If the licensee changes trainers, the licensee must:

- a) provide written notice to their former trainer, new trainer, the race secretary and the LGCA using a form approved by the LGCA; and
- b) ensure the forms required by the LGCA are signed by the former trainer, new trainer and the licensee before moving the horse to the new trainer's stall area.

3.10

The licensee must not move or permit the move of their horse from the stall of their former trainer until the licensee has notified the former trainer in writing of their intention to change trainers.

3.11

The licensee must not move or permit to be moved any horse they owned from the grounds of a race track operator unless approved to do so by a race administration official.

3.12

The licensee must only use a licensed veterinarian for veterinary services for any horse under their care.
